In 1757, Joseph Stanislas Gruaud drafted a **new wine estate** on the parish Saint Julien. At his death, he left the very well-maintained property to Monsieur de Larose and, from 1781, the château became "Gruaud Larose" and **rapidly famous for the great quality of its wines.**

From the top of our tower, you will enjoy the **unobstructed view** of the Medoc hills, vineyards and estuary. Looking into the distance, you will plunge into the fabulous history of the chateau, its terroirs and its wines.

Then we will share **some of the secrets** behind this classified Grand Cru through an exploration of our magnificent vat house and cellars.

The tour ends with a visit in the exceptional underground facilities and with a tasting of our 2 wines.
